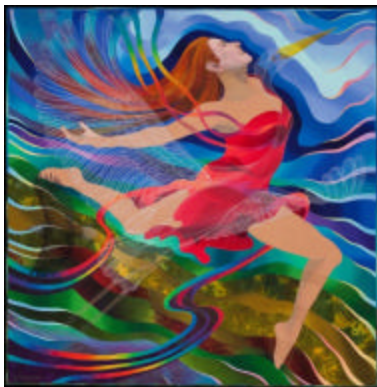


## Biography



Caryl Bryer Fallert is internationally recognized for her award winning fine art quilts. She is best known for her organic, curved seam designs, her scintillating use of color, and her multilevel illusions of light and motion. Her attention to detail has earned her a reputation for fine craftsmanship as well as stunning designs. Honors include: 100 Most Important Quilts of the Twentieth Century (2000), 30 Most Influential Quiltmakers in the World (2002), Bernina Quilt Leadership Award (2003), All American Quilter (2004) and International Quilt Festival Silver Star (lifetime achievement) Award (2006).



Since 1983, Caryl's work has been exhibited extensively throughout North America, Europe, Japan, and the Pacific Rim. She has had twelve solo exhibitions, including a 1992 exhibition in Tokyo, Japan, and a 2000 exhibition in Burlington, Ontario, Canada.

Caryl is the only three-time winner of the coveted American Quilters Society Best of Show, Purchase Award. Her quilts have also won Best

of Show in the International Quilt Association Show and more than a dozen other national and international exhibitions. In 1986, Caryl received the Masterpiece Quilt Award from the



National Quilting Association. She has received Master Awards for both Contemporary Artistry (2002 & 2006) and Machine Artistry (1997) from the International Quilt Association, and machine workmanship awards from both the American Quilters Society (2004 & 2009) and the Quilting the Quilt national exhibition (2003).

Caryl has authored two books, and numerous workshops on CD-ROM. Her work has appeared in hundreds of national and international publications, including the covers of the 1987 and 1991 Quilt National Catalogs.

Caryl's work can be found in public, museum, corporate, and private collections in twenty-two states and seven foreign countries. Collections include: The Museum of Art and Design (NY), National Quilt Museum, Illinois State Museum, International Quilt Study Center, Wilmette (IL)



Public Library, Bradley University Library, Glendale (CA) Civic Center, Fidelity Investments Inc., Sprint, and Fritz Gegauf A.G. (Switzerland). In addition to her commission work, Caryl reserves time to create a body of very personal, experimental quilts.

Born in 1947 in Elgin, Illinois, Caryl graduated with a BA from Wheaton College in 1969. She also studied art at Illinois State University, College of DuPage, and University of Wisconsin.

Caryl was a lifelong resident of Northern Illinois, until 2005, when she moved to Paducah, Kentucky, to take part in that city's artist relocation program. In April of 2006, she opened the Bryerpatch Studio shop, gallery, and workshop center in Paducah's historic Lower Town Arts District.

Caryl has lectured and conducted workshops for quilt and textile arts groups throughout the United States, and in eleven foreign countries on five continents. Her goal as a workshop leader is to help each student find the key to her/his personal creative style.

## Artists Statement



For as long as I can remember, I have expressed myself through artwork. My formal training was primarily in design, drawing, and studio painting. After many years of painting, sewing, and experimenting with other media, I discovered that fabric, as used as a fine art medium, best expressed my personal vision. I love the tactile qualities of cloth, and the unlimited color range made possible by hand dyeing and painting.



Since 1982, I have been a quilt maker, i.e., my work is constructed from layers of fabric, stitched together with batting or other filler between the layers. Most of my current work is made from cotton fabric, which is first hand dyed and painted, then pieced, appliquéd, embroidered, and quilted by machine.



Textures, created by layering, pleating, and quilting, invite the viewer to touch, as well as look. Recent works include a series of images designed using a computer assisted drawing program, and printed directly on cloth.



The focus of my work is on the qualities of color, line, and texture, which will engage the spirit and emotions of the viewer, evoking a sense of mystery, excitement, or joy.



Illusions of movement, depth, and luminosity are common to most of my work. The inner glow is created by hand dyeing or painting my fabrics in gradual progressions from light to dark.

Both my geometric color studies, and my more organic, curved seam abstracts are inspired by visual impressions, collected in my travels, in my everyday life, and in my imagination. Although some of my quilts include pictorial images, my work is most often about seeing, experiencing, and imagining, rather than pictorial representation of any specific object or species. My intention is to focus on positive energy and depict that in my work.



I intend for my quilts to be seen and enjoyed by others. It is my hope that they will lift the spirits and delight the eyes of those who see them.



I am constantly learning, as I find new images in my imagination and develop the techniques to create them in cloth. As a teacher I believe that the magic of art lies in our heads and in our hearts. I love sharing my techniques with others so they can share their magic with me.
