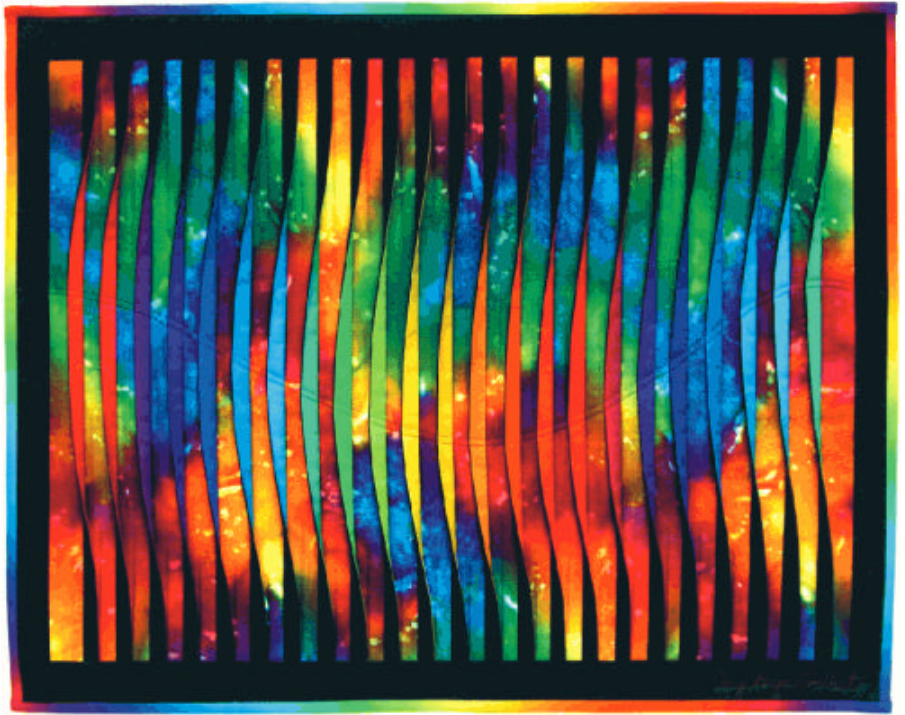

SUPPLIES

Fabric:

A complete kit will be provided for \$30.00

Sewing Machine:

1. One that is friendly and well adjusted. (Zigzag will be useful, but not absolutely essential)
2. If you own a walking foot or “even feed” foot, please bring it with you.

Other

1. Thread: medium gray or other neutral (cotton, polyester, or cotton/poly)
2. Iron (Preferably with steam- may be shared with 2-3 others)
3. Table Top Ironing Pad
4. Scissors (for paper and fabric)
5. Rotary cutter, board, and 24” ruler (gridded rotary mat is preferred)
6. Long, heavy-duty extension cord with at least two outlets.
7. Pencil
8. Litter bag

Classroom requirements:

A digital program will be used in this class, so a screen and the ability to see digital images in the classroom will be important.
