Make this 24" square wall hanging while learning Caryl's fast, easy and accurate method for piecing the curves in her quilts. You will also learn to piece flying geese in a curve, spiky things, and appliqué. In the two-day class, Caryl will also demonstrate machine quilting. You will learn about working with intersecting color gradations and creating shadows for extra drama in your designs. A pattern, printed on freezer paper, will be provided for \$12.00.

This is recommended as a two-day workshop. In the one day class you will have a chance to try a little of each technique, but you will need to finish the project at home.



## Supplies Needed:

**FABRIC:** An optional kit of all the fabrics you will need to make the quilt can be provided for \$55.00. If you would prefer to bring your own fabric from home, or use different colors, here are the fabrics and amounts used in the original sample:

From the Benartex, Glacier Park Collection or similar: (Preview at the Bryerpatch Studio Internet Store: [www.bryerpatch.com](http://www.bryerpatch.com))

- \* "fat" quarter yard 335-50 Turquoise Lake (very light turquoise)
- \* "fat" quarter yard 335-46 Lupine (multicolored rainbow fabric)
- \* 1/2 yard 334-55 Cobalt Lake (very dark blue)
- \* 1 yard 335-55 Glacier Blue (for binding, back and hanging sleeve) (medium blue on blue)
- \* 1/2 yard solid black
- \* Hand dyed "rainbow" fabric gradations or the following fabrics from Caryl's Gradations Collection (style 2046) from Benartex:
  - ~ 1/2 yard Periwinkle -fuchsia #56.
  - ~ 1/2 yard Fuchsia-Sunshine #63
  - ~ 1/2 yard Lapis -Sunshine #53

### Thread:

1. Clear and smoke monofilament (polyester is recommended)
2. Neutral color of cotton or polyester
3. Pale blue
4. Black
5. A variety of machine quilting threads in colors that match the fabric. (two day class only)
  - \* Batting: 26" square (for pinning up your project while you work)
  - \* Sewing Machine: One that is friendly and well adjusted. You must know how to operate your sewing machine. Your machine must have ZIGZAG. Bring the following feet if you have them. (Bernina #20 open toed embroidery foot, #10 edge foot, #24 open toed darning foot, walking foot)
  - \* Heavy duty Extension Cord with two outlets. Three prong adaptor if needed for classroom outlets
  - \* Basic Sewing Kit for hand and machine sewing.
  - \* Iron: Preferably with steam
  - \* Table Top Ironing Pad
  - \* Scissors (paper and fabric) **Please bring good scissors. You will hold up the whole class if you bring kindergarten scissors.**
  - \* Rotary Cutter, Board and Ruler
  - \* Drawing Tools:

- ~ Sharpie or other fine point felt tip marker.
- ~ White quilt marking pencil. Sanford Verithin or white charcoal are recommended. (two day class only)
- \* Small watercolor brush or cotton swab.
- \* Spray Starch or small container of other liquid starch. You will not need much. You can just spray some starch into a hotel size shampoo bottle or other tight container.
- \* Glue Stick
- \* Scotch brand magic tape or other non-shiny cellophane tape
- \* Litter Bag
- \* Paper
  - ~ A few sheets of paper for notes and for trying out quilting patterns
  - ~ Postcard, or index card

### OPTIONAL:

- \* Small Portable Light Box (If you are driving and already have one)
- \* If you have a plexi extension table for your machine, bring it. A light stick can be slipped underneath to form a portable light box.
- \* "Add a Quarter" ruler if you already have one.
